What is HIPPY?

- A free, home-based preschool program complete with story-books and activity packets;
- A program designed to help parents help their children develop school readiness skills;
- A program that focuses on language development and problem solving skills, as well as all other basic skills necessary to enter school prepared to succeed.

How Does It Work?

Parent Educators meet with parents weekly to role-play the HIPPY lessons. The parent works with his or her child for 15 minutes a day, five days a week, teaching them from the HIPPY lessons. Parent group meetings are held that provide beneficial information to help families grow and thrive. The program, its curriculum, and all activities associated with it are 100% free to participating families.

HIPPY is a free program that is offered to the families in Montgomery County.
