FIRST CLASS PRE-K PRE-REGISTRATION



Nationally Recognized Program

Montgomery Public Schools are now accepting online pre-registration applications for the 2020—2021 school year. Enrollment is open to all children four years of age on or before September 1st who are residents of the state of Alabama. Children who are eligible for kindergarten are ineligible for Pre-K. Parents can complete the online pre-registration application on any device (computer, iPad/tablet, phone, etc.) that has internet access. You will receive an email confirming your child's pre-registration. Computer access and assistance completing the online pre-registration application will also be available at the McKee Pre-K Center, Monday—Thursday from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Pre-Registration Requirements:

- Applicants must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate. The birth certificate may be uploaded into the online pre-registration site or submitted to the secretary at the McKee Pre-K Center.
- Applicants must provide two proofs of residence: either a current utility bill (e.g. electric, gas, water) or a copy of a lease or mortgage. These documents may be uploaded into the online registration site or they may be submitted to the secretary at the McKee Pre-K Center.
- We recommend that applicants apply only to their zoned school.
- MPS Pre-K Sites- Brewbaker, Dannelly, Halcyon, Highland Ave., Highland Gardens, King (MLK), McKee Pre-K Center, Pintlala, Southlawn, and Wares Ferry

If selected for Pre-K, your child's current immunization record must be provided to complete enrollment. No child will be denied participation on the basis of income, sex, race, color, national origin, or disability. If you have questions, please call (334) 223-6801.
