- Teachers will provide live lessons during the appropriate time frame based on the virtual schedule posted on our website.
- Teachers will provide standard based instruction that will require student attendance, participation, and assignment completion.
- Teachers will be available, based on the virtual schedule, to provide intervention, tutoring, and parent conferences.
